



E-Learn Card Contest

Official Rules

- Purpose:** The E-Learn Card is an incentive program, designed to encourage students to become involved with experiential learning programming and services.
- Eligibility:** Eligible participants include new students entering Keuka College in the beginning of the Fall 2008 semester.
- Prize:** The grand prize is a \$150 gift card to the Keuka College bookstore.
- How to win:** Students must present their E-Learn Card (received during Transition Week) at eligible experiential learning events (listed below). The cards will be initialed by a staff member at the time of the event/appointment. Students must turn in their card to the Center for Experiential Learning once they have received six sets of initials (in the six designated boxes) to be entered into the drawing. Students can get a new E-Learn Card once they have turned in a full card. A random drawing of submitted cards will determine the winner.
- Dates:** The E-Learn Card contest will begin Aug. 25, 2008 and end with the **drawing on Dec. 3, 2008 at noon**. All qualifying cards must be turned into the Center for Experiential Learning by this time. The winner will be notified via Keuka e-mail on this day and must claim the prize by the end of finals week on Dec. 10.
- Events:** Students should pay attention to event advertising (online calendar at www.keuka.edu/experiential, flyers, e-mails, ANNOUNCE, etc.) to keep up-to-date on upcoming experiential learning events. Here are some qualifying events:

 - Alumni Networking Fair, Sept. 19
 - Experiential Learning Fair, Sept. 25
 - *Individual appointments re: resumes, cover letters, choosing a major, Field Period, work-study, community service, co-curricular transcripts, and any other experiential learning related topic
 - Submitting a Big Brothers Big Sisters application
 - Volunteering in the community (verification required)
 - Initiating a TeamWorks! program
 - Co-curricular transcript presentation during club meetings
 - Other events as determined by the Center for Experiential Learning

*Center staff members reserve the right to limit the number of credits (initials) students can receive for multiple appointments of the same type. For example, students will receive credit for initial resume appointments, but not for follow-up appointments for that same résumé.
